## Frank W. Liebl

Frank W. Liebl, 90, of 503 Euclid Avenue, died Sunday afternoon at the Sheboygan Retirement Home where he resided for the past six weeks.

He was born January 11, 1894, in the city of Sheboygan, a son of George and Anna Kroeff Liebl.

He attended local schools and worked as a plumber for various concerns in the city.

He was a veteran of World War One.

On June 24, 1926, he was married to Helen Schroam who preceded him in death in 1979. Only immediate survivors are a brother, Allan of La Jolla, California, and two sisters, Angeline and Jennie of Sheboygan, with whom he made his home. Three brothers and one sister died before he did. Nieces and nephews also survive.

The funeral Mass will be celebrated by the Reverend James Hess, associate Pastor, Wednesday at 10:00 AM at Holy Name Church, following family rites at the Kroos Mason Funeral home, at 9:30 AM. Burial will be in Calvary Cemetery.
