### George W. Liebl

George W. Liebl, 71, well-known Sheboygan resident, passed away at his home, 1328 N. 9th St., early this morning following a long illness.

Born in Sheboygan, the son of George and Annie Kroeff Liebl, on Jan. 1, 1878, he received his education at Holy Name School and the Sheboygan Business College. He graduated from the Pharmacy School at Marquette University and was employed as a pharmacist at the Neumeister Pharmacy in this city, and later for drug stores in Milwaukee and Madison.

He was employed as a salesman for the American Chair Co. for a number of years and from 1927 to 1940 he managed the Gerend Furniture Store and Funeral Home; and from 1940 to 1946 was employed by the Kroos Funeral Home. He retired in 1946 because of ill health.

His marriage to Ida Albers was solemnized at Holy Name Church by the late Msgr. D. F. Thill on June 27, 1912.

He was a life-long member of Holy Name Church and was a member of the Holy Name Society, Knights of Columbus, Third order of St. Francis, the Apostolate of Suffering and the Happy Death Society.

Survivors are his wife; four brothers, Allan of San Diego, Calif., Edmund J. and Frank of Sheboygan, and Father Leo Liebl of St. Francis, Wis.; and two sisters, the Misses Jennie and Angeline of Sheboygan. He was preceded in death by a sister, Mrs. John Maersch Sr.

Funeral services will be held Saturday with brief family rites at 8:30 a.m. at Gerend's Funeral Home, Followed by a solemn high mass at 9 o'clock at Holy Name Church. Father Leo Liebl will be the celebrant and burial will be on the family lot in Calvary Cemetery.

Friends may call at the funeral Home from 2 o'clock Friday afternoon until the time of services.
