Services For George Liebl, Sr., Will Be Conducted On Tuesday

Funeral services for George Liebl, Sr., who died at 6 a.m. Friday at the family residence, 814 St. Clair Avenue, will be held at Holy Name church at 9 a.m. Tuesday.

Mr. Liebl was a lifelong resident of Sheboygan and for many years one of the leading businessmen of this community. He was born in this city on July 22, 1857, the son of George and Magdalene Liebl. For 40 years he was associated with the late John Silbernagel in the firm of Silbernagel and Liebl. After Mr. Silbernagel's death, Mr. Liebl continued the business alone for a short time and then engaged in the real estate business for some years.

He was married to Miss Anna Kroeff on July 24, 1883, by the Rev. Michael Heider. They celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary on July 24, 1933.

Surviving Mr. Liebl are his wife, five sons and three daughters, George, Jr., Edmund, Allan, Frank, Leo, Mrs. John Maersch, Angeline and Jenny. Also surviving are 12 grandchildren, one great-grandchild, and three brothers, John, Henry, and William, all of this city. Two sisters, Mrs. A. J. Vollrath and Amelia Liebl, and three brothers, Jacob, Joseph and August Liebl, preceded him in death.

Mr. Liebl was an active member of Holy Name congregation and the Holy Name society.
