Funeral services were held Monday in Columbia, SC., for **John M. Maersch** of Columbia, a Sheboygan native who died May 8 at Dwight D. Eisenhower Hospital, Ft. Gordon, GA.

He was the son of John and Olivia Liebl Maersch.

Mr. Maersch graduated from the University of Wisconsin - Madison in 1934, a member of Phi Kappa Phi Fraternity.

He served in World War II and the Korean War, retiring from the Air Force after 28½ years service.

After his retirement, Mr. Maersch was associated with Wilbur Smith and Associates and the South Carolina Disaster Preparedness Unit.

He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church, Columbia, the South Carolina State Employees Association, the Columbia Chapter of the Retired Officers' Association, and the Knights of Columbus.

Survivors are his wife, Mrs. Loraine Poole Maersch; a son, John of Columbia; three brothers, William of Sheboygan, Robert of Severna Park, Md., and Arthur of West Allis; a sister, Mrs. Edward Barbuch of Sheboygan.

Services were held Monday at Dunbar Funeral Home, Columbia. Burial with full military honors was in Greenlawn Memorial Park, Columbia.

A memorial fund has been established in Mr. Maersch's name for the South Carolina Lung Association.
